GRAND CANYON STATE UNIVERSITY GRANT.* High school students (grades 9-12) who are accepted to attend Grand Canyon University will receive a \$250 GCU grant. The grant is divided into \$125 for the fall and spring semesters as long as the student maintains the minimum GPA requirements.

DEGREE SCHOLARSHIP FOR MEMBERS. ALPHA participants will have access to an exclusive **10% scholarship** for their group's members and governing board members**, providing savings toward tuition and fees for online undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree programs at GCU.

CONTINUING EDUCATION/SINGLE COURSE SCHOLARSHIP. ALPHA participants will have access to a **10% scholarship** providing savings for non-degree single courses and continuing teacher education courses.

SCHOLARSHIP FOR SPOUSES. Exclusive **5% degree scholarship** for spouses of ALPHA group's members and governing board members**, providing savings toward tuition and fees for online undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree programs at GCU.

COHORTS. ALPHA participants may request that cohorts be developed for continuing education, individual courses and/or degree programs online or at an approved ALPHA site or regionally approved GCU site.

DUAL ENROLLMENT. ALPHA participants will have access to a catalog of online dual enrollment courses for current high school students, offering them an opportunity to reduce the time needed to complete a bachelor's degree from four years to three. **This could reduce college costs by up to 25%.**

TODAYSLEARN. ALPHA participants will receive access to GCU's TodaysLearn services. Available TodaysLearn opportunities include: Speakers Bureau (motivational speaking and lectures), Professional Development (instruction based on specific subject matter and customized to address specific needs), and Coaching, Mentoring and Consultation (individualized assistance in areas requested).

EVENT DISCOUNTS. ALPHA participants receive priority communication about events on GCU's campus. ALPHA members and their families will receive discounts for GCU academic and athletic camps along with other events sponsored by Strategic Educational Alliances.

This award cannot be combined with the CCSC Scholarship. **Benefits available to governing board members would be subject to each homeschool group's policies. GCU scholarships may be combined up to the following limits: Chancellor/President Award recipients in campus housing – up to \$16,500, all other scholarship recipients in campus housing – up to \$16,500, all other scholarships.
