

COMMENCEMENT PARKING INSTRUCTIONS FOR GRADUATES AND GUESTS

Below you will find resources and helpful tips regarding travel to and from Grand Canyon University, as well as parking on campus. It's recommended to check traffic and construction information at az511.gov or by calling 888-411-ROAD (7623).

TRAVEL

Travel time varies based on your location in Phoenix. Please plan accordingly. The following are estimated commute times to campus. Please allow 30 – 45 minutes of additional time for parking, as well as walking to and entering GCU Arena.

- Coming from East Valley (Mesa, Gilbert, Chandler): 45 minutes to an hour
- Coming from Northeast Valley (Scottsdale): 30 to 45 minutes
- Coming from West Valley: 20 minutes

Please note, campus will be in session with ground student classes Monday - Friday. Traffic to and on campus may be exceptionally busy. Please plan accordingly.

PARKING

5 pm Ceremony

Parking is available at the 33rd Avenue garage (3300 W. Camelback Road, Phoenix, AZ 85017), located next to GCU Arena. We ask that those traveling **northbound on I-17** exit at Camelback Road to 33rd Avenue.

Those traveling **southbound on I-17** should exit at Bethany Home Road to 35th Avenue, travel south on 35th Avenue and then travel east on Camelback Road to the 33rd Avenue garage.

Additional parking will be located at the 31st Avenue garage (3050 W. Camelback Road, Phoenix, AZ 85017), conveniently located less than one block from GCU Arena.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Phoenix police officers will be directing traffic during the ceremony. Depending upon traffic flow and available parking, traffic officers may direct you to an alternate parking location.

If you will be arriving to campus via Rideshare: The rideshare drop-off and pickup location address is 3000 W. Colter St., Phoenix, AZ 85017.

Handicapped parking is located in our 33rd Avenue garage. Please have your handicapped plaque displayed, so traffic officers can help direct you accordingly.

Vehicles parked in non-designated parking areas on private property may be subject to towing and impoundment at the owner's expense.
