Business Simulator Challenge

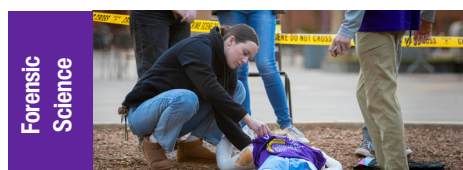
